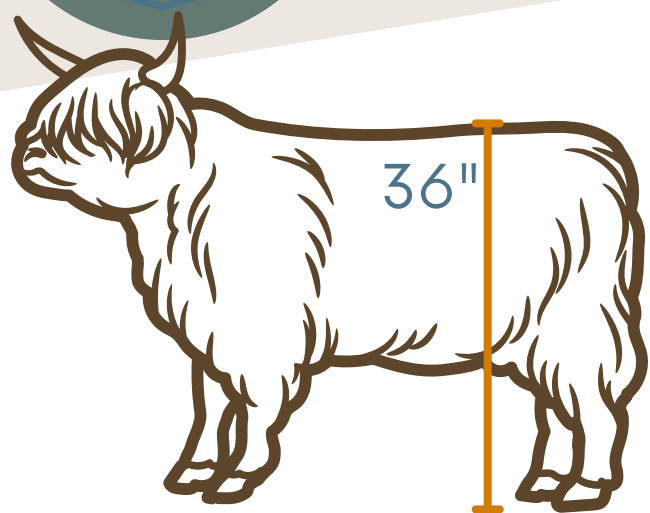
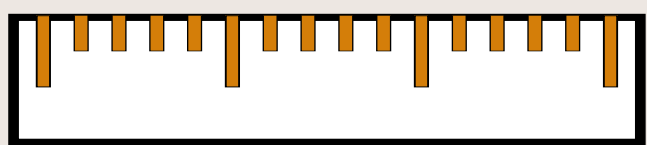


# HOW TO MEASURE YOUR MINI HIGHLANDS

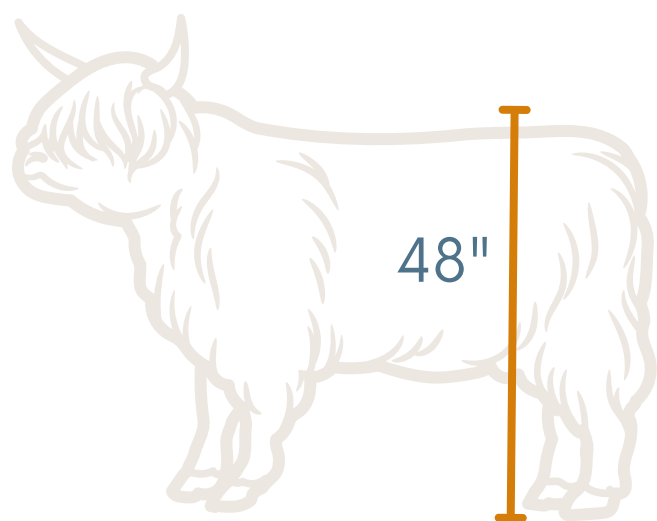
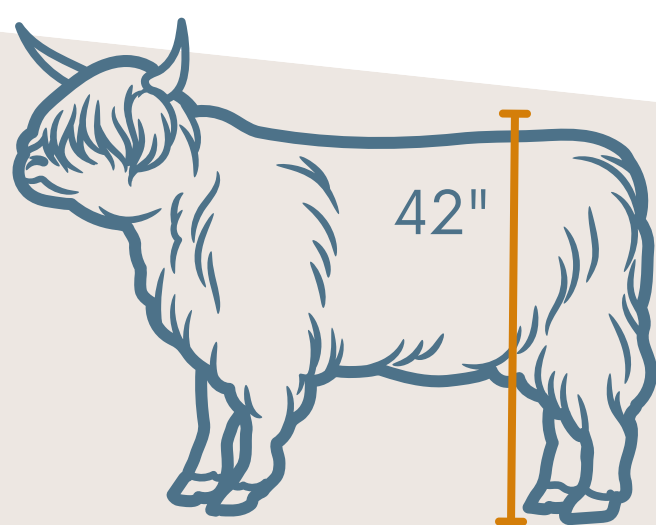


## Micro Highland

Measuring 36" tall and under at the top of the back.

## Mini Highland

Measuring 36.25" - 42" at the top of the back.

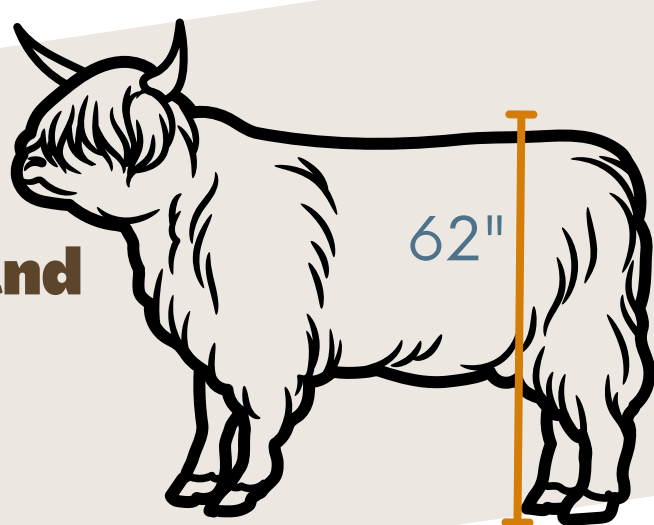


## Midsized Highland

Measuring 42.25" - 48" at the top of the back.

## Full size/Standard Highland

Measuring over 48" at the top of the back.



## When To Measure

Mature height is taken at 3 years old. All cattle are assumed to have reached maturity at that age, even though they will slowly continue to grow as long as they live. Measurements must be taken on a level surface. A helpful tool is a sliding T-square. Ensure both the upright and horizontal bars are level. Remember, an accurate measurement is critical to the integrity of your program.
